# **CAPE COD BY LAND, SAIL & RAIL**

## **Featuring a Visit to the Foxwoods Casino 5 Days - 4 Nights**

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 -** A White Star Tours representative will greet you upon arrival in Cape Cod. You will have time to check in at your motel and enjoy a welcome reception. Then, prepare for your first dinner on the Cape. Have an enjoyable evening.
- Day 2 -** Following breakfast, your local guide will meet you at the motel for a full day of discovering the beauty of the Cape. You begin in the “hub” of Hyannis where you will stop at the Kennedy Memorial and the Korean War Memorial; drive along Main Street and through the village of Hyannisport and view St. Francis Xavier Church. Then, travel along scenic Route 6A to learn about the history as you drive through colonial villages that are filled with wonderful examples of New England architecture. Stop at the Eastham Windmill, view a lighthouse and drive through the Cape Cod National Seashore area. You will be surrounded by the ocean and sand dunes as you approach “land’s End” — Provincetown. This is a wonderful destination with a rich heritage that combines a love of the sea and the arts. There will be free time for shopping and lunch on your own. Dinner this evening is included.
- Day 3 -** After breakfast, you will meet your guide at the motel for a “Sail & Rail” tour. Begin on the water with a one-hour narrated Hyannis Harbor Cruise. Back on dry land you will climb aboard the Cape Cod Central Railroad for a journey through the Cape’s landscape from Hyannis to Sandwich. Sandwich is the oldest village on the Cape. You will have free time for lunch on your own. Today’s highlight is admission to the Heritage Museums & Gardens. Heritage offers an eclectic mix of beautiful gardens, folk art, antique cars, a windmill and a fully restored carousel from 1912. There is a trolley that will help you explore all that there is to see. Dinner and entertainment will complete your day.
- Day 4 -** Enjoy breakfast, then meet your guide at the motel for a final day of touring. Arrive in Boston for a city tour which will include Back Bay, Public Garden, Boston Common, and many more sights along the Freedom Trail. You will also view the U.S.S. Constitution and enjoy free time for lunch on your own and shopping at Quincy Market. Later, you will stop in America’s hometown, Plymouth, where you will see the Forefather’s Monument, Plymouth Rock, and the Mayflower II. A lobster dinner will complete your day.
- Day 5 -** After breakfast, check out and prepare for your departure home with lasting memories of your trip to Cape Cod. En route home you will stop at the Foxwoods Casino for a chance at winning the jackpot. After your visit, depart for home.
