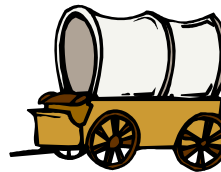

GRAND CANYON OF PENNSYLVANIA

3 DAYS - 2 NIGHTS

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

Day 1 An early morning departure has you heading north into the Williamsport, PA area. Upon arrival meet your guide for a tour of Millionaires Row where each person will join the ranks of the "millionaires." Later, visit the Taber Museum at the Lycoming County Historical Society including the Shempp Toy Train Collection. Later, you will stop at Susquehanna State Park where you will board the *Hiawatha* for a 1-hour sightseeing cruise on the Susquehanna River. Continue to your lodging in the area where you will check in and have a chance to freshen up. Tonight enjoy a fantastic dinner on Millionaires Row at the historic Peter Herdic House.

Day 2 Enjoy a deluxe continental breakfast at your motel, then depart north into Wellsboro, PA where you will meet your guide upon arrival. Your guide will lead the way to the Grand Canyon of Pennsylvania where you will board a wagon for a tour of the Upper Gorge. There will be time for lunch on your own and browsing in downtown Wellsboro, then travel to Leonard Harrison State Park where you will have a chance to observe from the Overlook. In the afternoon, board the Tioga Central Railroad for a train ride to Hammond Lake. Dinner has been arranged in the area, then return to your motel for a restful evening.

Day 3 Following a deluxe continental breakfast at the motel, it is time to checkout. The group will stop in Lewisburg, PA where you'll meet your guide and continue to the Mifflinburg Buggy Museum featuring an actual 19th Century Buggy Makers Workshop, plus a buggy collection. There will be time for lunch on your own in Lewisburg followed by a visit to Colonial Candlecrafters for a workshop tour and candle-decorating demonstration. Before leaving the area you will enjoy a historic tour of Lewisburg, then bid farewell to your guide and depart for home.
