



The history of WHITE STAR TOURS

...truly an American dream come true!



As of 2026, our White Star Tour company will be celebrating our 55th year in business. There are not many companies of any type that can boast of such a long history of serving our wonderful customers in the United States and Canada. Over the years, we have faced many headwinds, like economic depressions, the tragedy of 9/11, and most recently the incredible challenge of the Corona Virus Pandemic, however, with the help of a wonderful family and staff, we have been able to persevere and flourish, making many friends along the way. Once again, in answer to so many requests from so many of our loyal group leaders, we are presenting to you the proud history of our White Star Tour company:

the Kraras family...

The White Star Tours Company is rooted in the Kraras Family. Our father, Gus Kraras, was born and raised in Greece, and immigrated to the United States when he was 17 in an attempt to support his starving family in the mountains of Greece. Gus worked very hard at many jobs for his first few years in America. But, when the Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor in 1941, he felt the calling to serve his new country of the United States, and immediately enlisted into the US Army. He served proudly and courageously for four years, and actually became part of the first group of members of the OSS (Organization of Strategic Services) which was the forerunner of today's CIA. After being honorably discharged in 1945, he settled into the Reading, PA area, and in 1946 married Stella Dialectos, a first-generation Greek family acquaintance. In 1947 they welcomed their first-born son, Chris (who is the author of this history); in 1951 their daughter, Angel, was born; several years later, in 1962, the birth of their younger daughter, Patricia, completed the family unit.

the beginning of a dream...

Gus and Stella operated luncheonettes and small restaurants in the Reading area. In 1954 they traveled to Wildwood, NJ to build on their restaurant experience. During the summer months, they operated the Lorraine Restaurant in Wildwood, along with their young children, Chris and Angel. They purchased the Lorraine Hotel that was attached to the restaurant and began expanding their work in the hospitality industry. They realized that in order to extend the summer season and bring in a few more customers and income, they could welcome small groups of 5, 10 or 15 people during what became known as the "off season" of May and September. It was in 1970 that Chris, along with his Father, decided to bring a few bus loads of customers from their home area of Reading, PA to the Wildwood area for packages lasting two and three nights.

In 1972, the Kraras Family purchased the White Star Motel in Wildwood. Ann, Chris's wife, became its first manager and through the years continues to be Chris's biggest business and personal supporter. It was during this year that the name White Star Tours was born. They started bringing more and more groups into the Wildwood area and the White Star Tours Company was born. Simultaneously, Chris was a high school teacher in Birdsboro, PA, and juggled his teaching career with this growing travel business. The number of bus groups grew over the next few years as the company expanded by hosting groups not only from Reading, but from other areas of PA. Chris welcomed his brother-in-law, Mauro Cammarano, husband of his sister, Angel, to join him in this effort as the business extended into new areas.

expanding the base...

By 1980, White Star Tours was attracting groups from states like New York, New Jersey, Massachusetts, Delaware, Maryland and Virginia. Chris began developing trips to other popular seashore locations including Ocean City, MD, Myrtle Beach, SC, Virginia Beach, VA and Cape Cod, MA. With this rapid and continued growth, White Star Tours was outgrowing the spare bedroom in Chris's home that had served as its office. Mauro worked alongside of Chris on snack trays. As a result, the current and much larger White Star Headquarters was permanently established at 26 East Lancaster Avenue in Reading, PA.

As the company grew, wonderful co-workers were hired, most of whom are still working here today! As the staff grew, so did the business, and many additional tour destination were added. Since 1985, White Star Tours continues to expand it's geographical boundaries to include states like Ohio, Michigan, North Carolina and South Carolina. Chris was forced to retire from teaching, which he truly loved, in order to manage the business full time. Mauro, then followed Chris and left his teaching position as well to work full time. Shortly thereafter, Chris's sister, Pat, graduated from college and joined the company where she has remained as Chief Financial Officer.

a family affair...

From there, the story becomes more heartwarming as more family members and outstanding co-workers were hired. The original officers were Chris as President, Mauro as Vice President, Pat as Treasurer and Gus as Secretary. It wasn't too long after that Chris was able to welcome his son, Dean, the current President, into the fold, and soon thereafter his daughter, Marisa. A few years later, Mauro's son, Drew, current Vice-President, and his daughter, Stephanie were hired. To make the family story complete, Pat married Bernie Donahue, who also joined the White Star family ranks. Eventually their children, Bern and Stavanna, became part of the family business.

a long and wonderful ride with a slight change of leadership...

White Star continues to spread its wings by serving groups from virtually every state in the country and Provinces throughout Canada. The White Star Family continues to grow. I was very proud three years ago to appoint my son, Dean Kraras, as the President of our White Star Tours Company. I also appointed my nephew, Andrew Cammarano, as the Vice President and my sister, Pat Donahue, as our Treasurer. I am still very actively involved in the company, but I realize that we must be mindful to make sure that our legacy continues to grow and flourish going forward.

Sadly, we lost a few people along the way — my Mother passed away in 2011, and my Father, Gus, died in 2018. Very tragically this past November, my beloved wife, Ann, who was always so intricately involved in the business, passed away suddenly and unexpectedly from pancreatic cancer. All our family is still trying to adjust. But, we will persevere, as we always have, knowing that they are looking down on us from Heaven, guiding us in our efforts to make as many people as we can happy by enjoying their opportunity to see the World.

In completing this brief history of White Star Tours and the Kraras Family, I would like to express my sincere thanks to God for all His many blessings, and my heartfelt thanks to the literally millions of people who have traveled with our company over all these many years.



Most Frequently Asked Questions

- ? You have so many wonderful tours, how do I choose? Take our booklet to your next meeting, and find which tours interest your group. Choose as many as the group would like for the year.
- ?What do I do if I need more information? Call us at 1-800-437-2323. A tour consultant will help answer your questions and send you more information on the tours you select. If you like working with a particular consultant, ask for him or her.
- ?Do tour prices include transportation? Because we serve groups from all over the United States and Canada, it is not possible to include the transportation costs in this book. It is your preference as to who will make the transportation arrangements. You can contact the bus company you use, or we can give you one complete price for the tour AND the transportation based on the number of people that will be traveling with you on your tour.
- ? How do I reserve a tour, and do I receive a contract? After a date is chosen for the tour, your tour consultant will send you a letter/ contract confirming the details of your tour.
- ?What happens after my tour is reserved? After your tour is confirmed, the tour consultant in charge of the destination you chose makes all lodging, attraction and meal arrangements for you. Your consultant will work with you on your tour until its completion.
- ?When I reserve a bus tour, do I need to send a deposit? In most bus tours we ask that you send an initial deposit of \$200 one month after reserving your tour, followed by \$25 per person after you've received deposits from your group members. The balance is due 45 days before your tour. Payments are always refundable up to two months before your tour should you not get a sufficient response. We will be glad to work with you in meeting payment schedules.
- **?** To whom do we send the payments? Make checks payable to: White Star Tours, and send them to: 26 E. Lancaster Avenue, Reading, PA 19607. We will send you receipts for all your payments.
- ? If a person has to cancel at the last minute, will they get a refund? We always work with you in refunding everything we can in the event of a cancellation. If cancellations for bus
